## Introduction

This document is a bridge between the strategy set by Church Council and the work we as a congregation need to complete to realize that strategy.

### Mission

We are disciples of Jesus Christ in an accepting community of faith compassionately serving others in God's name.

## Vision

At Mill Plain United Methodist Church, we help people connect with God, get spiritually fed, and become disciples of Jesus Christ. By 2026, with God's help we will achieve the following milestones and much more.

## Worship

- We will have a service or services that are both in-person and live online worship.
- We will have a visible and active connection between the Preschool and the church.
- We will expand our music program beyond a choir and a praise band.

### **Social Justice**

- As a congregation, we will be actively advocating for the marginalized. We will have a social justice statement on our website.
- We will be an official Reconciling congregation, which openly accepts and affirms people of all gender identities, gender expressions, and sexual orientations.
- We will be a multi-generational and multi-ethnic congregation with programs, classes, and events that appeal to all age groups and that allow everyone to grow on their Christian journey.

#### Mission and Outreach

- We will expand our outreach into the community to bring help, comfort, and spiritual guidance to our neighbors in our community.
- **Mission**: We will be practicing asset-based outreach to the community, offering tailored assistance to those who come to us for help.
- Pastoral Care: We will continue with existing and expanding small shepherding groups led by lay people.
- Preschool: We will have a full slate of morning and afternoon classes, as well as additional enrichment activities.
- Youth and Education: The number of children, youth, young adult, and adult education programs will increase. Attendance and spiritual depth will grow. Programs will be available both in-person and online.
